Now is when your house starts looking like a home! Your walls and trim will first be primed then painted. All cabinets in the kitchen and bathrooms will be installed once painting is complete.

At the end of this stage, countertops will be installed. Countertops may be covered with cardboard to protect the surface. You are welcome to remove the cardboard to see your countertop, but please place the cardboard back before you leave.

Reminders:

- Paint and drywall touch-ups occur during and after the finishes stage.
- Paint and caulking splotches occur throughout the home. The final clean is set to address most of the areas.

Our recommendation will always be soap and water to clean your countertops.

However, it is important to remind homeowners to check the manufacturer's recommendations prior to cleaning countertops as countertop damage due to harsh or acidic cleaners is not covered by warranty. You can find a list of manufactures warranties on line on the homeowners website.
